Young's Schema Questionnaire was developed to assist clinicians in the assessment of the cognitions, affects, and behaviours that underlie psychopathology. This study examined the properties of the Schema Questionnaire in an Australian clinical population (N = 433). In accordance with an earlier study, 16 factors, including 15 of the original scales proposed by Young, emerged as primary components. A higher-order factor analysis was also found to closely resemble the classification system proposed by Young. This solution is shown to fit well with existing models of psychopathology.
